- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives

- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when

1	"ARTICLE—

- 2 "SECTION 1. ACCOUNTABILITY TO THE LAW.
  3 The Government established by this Constitution is a gov-
- 4 ernment of laws. Subject to the provisions of the first
- 5 clause of section 6 of article I, every person holding a posi-
- 6 tion of authority under the United States, including the
- 7 President and the Vice President, is accountable to the
- 8 law for their actions, both official and unofficial; every
- 9 such person is liable to prosecution and punishment in the
- 10 ordinary course of law. Laws of general applicability shall
- 11 be interpreted as applicable to the President unless other-
- 12 wise specified.
- "Section 2. ENFORCEMENT. This article is self-
- 14 executing. Congress shall have plenary power to make all
- 15 necessary rules and regulations designed to ensure the
- 16 general applicability and enforcement of criminal laws, in-
- 17 cluding by tolling the statute of limitations applicable to
- 18 a violation of the law by an incumbent President for the
- 19 duration of the term of office of the President.".
