"ARTICLE—

"SECTION 1. ACCOUNTABILITY TO THE LAW. 4 5 The Government established by this Constitution is a government of laws. Subject to the provisions of the first 6 7 clause of section 6 of article I, every person holding a posi-8 tion of authority under the United States, including the 9 President and the Vice President, is accountable to the 10 law for their actions, both official and unofficial; every such person is liable to prosecution and punishment in the 11 12 ordinary course of law. Laws of general applicability shall 13 be interpreted as applicable to the President unless other-14 wise specified.

15 "SECTION 2. ENFORCEMENT. This article is self-16 executing. Congress shall have plenary power to make all 17 necessary rules and regulations designed to ensure the 18 general applicability and enforcement of criminal laws, in-19 cluding by tolling the statute of limitations applicable to 20 a violation of the law by an incumbent President for the 21 duration of the term of office of the President.".
